### Telangana's Ramappa temple conferred UNESCO heritage tag

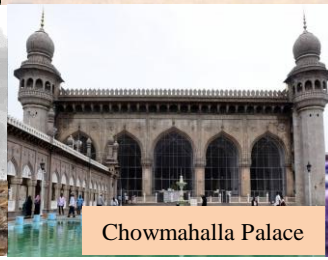
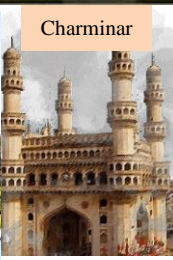
